Motions from October Meeting:

Accept the minutes as posted in the newsletter. Gene Patzsch made the motion, Eugene Sommers seconded the motion and the motion passed. Accept Richard Teaff as a new member. (Unanimous)

Sam welcomed the club members that were present and the one visitor. He asked if everyone received their newsletter. All present responded that they had.

Sam opened the floor for discussion of old business.

Sign:

Discussion: Gary Cowden has spoken with Powell Truck Body and got permission to re-install the sign at a location to be determined. In addition, Gary will determine the extent of the damage to the sign and recommend repairs. Mark Gryder agreed to address the status of the poles. Gary plans to meet with the Powell's and determine a suitable location. Mark needs to prepare the poles and contact VDOT to get a "blessing" on the new location. It is time to get moving on this so we can put our sign to improve our visibility.

Gary talked with Jeff Powell (no relation to the owners of Powell Trucking) to set up a meeting with Reggie. Reggie gave the OK to put the sign back up. Not sure if or how well Powell will repair the frame that was damaged during the removal by VDOT. Sam said that he could get the frame repaired by the same guys who made the frame for the cost of the materials. After finding a location and getting it approved by Powell, Mark will contact VDOT to get their blessing on the new location. Mark and Sam will try to remove the concrete from the old poles. If they find it too hard to do, Sam said he could probably get new poles for the sign. If the sign goes back where it was, but further from the road, Mark will check with Powell to see if we can cut back some of the trees, to allow east bound traffic to see the sign better.
