2007 Club Dues and Budget:

The Club Secretary will go over the proposed budget for 2007. In addition, we will discuss club dues and vote on changes if necessary at November meeting. The secretary will propose a two tiered club dues system which will include dues for people who don't want to mow and those that will. Lastly we will discuss whether we want to contribute to a charity for 2006.

Randy foresees us collecting about \$2000 in club dues with the way our club is currently growing. He has allocated for events like Day in the Park and more field maintenance. A copy of the proposed budget to be posted in the newsletter.

Two tiered dues for those that want to mow and higher for those that don't want to mow was determined to be too hard to control. Going to stick with current system but plan to enforce that members do cut always. If you do not want to cut the grass, you need to hire someone to cut it for you. The Cowden's have been doing it this year and do a rather good job. Decisions on whether the field actually needs to be cut or not is to be determined by club officers and the member(s) scheduled to mow will be contacted only if they are not to cut the grass. Plan on cutting it unless you hear otherwise.

Field Adjustments:

Last meeting there was discussion about field adjustments for widening the runway or having a cross runway. Jimmy Booth told everyone that this was something tried in the past that didn't work out. There isn't enough dirt over the trash and a cross runway is not really feasible with what we have now.

New Business

Flying at Falwell:

Gene brought up that it might be possible to fly at Falwell Airport. Falwell has lost a lot of students to the Lynchburg Regional Airport. There was a discussion about how narrow the area is and may not be exactly what would work well for us. Gene is going to research more and report at the next meeting.

Christmas Party:

Jimmy Booth asked about the Christmas Party. After a discussion about where to have it, should we provide our own food and deal with the clean up. Gene Patzsch made a motion, Jimmy Booth seconded the motion and the motion passed. With possible dates of Dec. 1st and Dec. 8th, Gene was going to check on the Golden Corral in Lynchburg and Randy to check with Country Cooking in Lynchburg.
